Dear Ms. Allen,

I am in receipt of letter dated April 10, 2013 from William Hood, attorney for the Respondent in the above matter. I submit the following response to the points raised in that correspondence.

Initially, Mr. Hood identifies that the Certification was dated April 4, 2013 and he received my letter on April 3, 2013. This is a very simply and innocent error in calendar reference as I personally signed the Certification and mailed it myself but for me to Date the Certification later would only hurt me and no one else.


Next, Mr. Hood indicates that I have not complied with instructions to submit the Designation of Matter in accordance with Rule 240 as instructed. This statement may not accurately reflect the circumstances surrounding the submission of this document. Specifically, when I realized I had not included the Designation of Matter I called the Court Clerk immediately to determine what I should do and I was advised that the document was required and then I received the Letter from the Court on March 27, 2013 and I mailed the Designation of Matter with a copy of the accompanying documents on April 2, 2013 only 5 days from receiving the Deficiency Letter from the Court and then sent all copies to the Court and to Mr. Hood with USPS Tracking.

As a pro se Appellant I do not know if this was procedurally correct, my intention was simply to provide the missing documents as rapidly as possible.

Finally, Mr. Hood suggests that there have been multiple delays and protractions in this case. This is an unfair characterization of my efforts in this matter and a veiled attempt to suggest that I have somehow endeavored to delay this case to the disadvantage of his client. To be clear, the primary delay in this matter was the ordering and receipt of the transcripts. The Court Reporter Jo Rice advised me upon ordering my transcripts that she had been the Court Reporter on 2 separate murder trials and a number of expedited Transcripts were requested so she did not start until September 25, 2012 and those previous had superseded my order and I have included a copy of the email from Ms. Rice (it was well over a month before the Transcripts were sent out according to the email included). The only other delay was approximately 30 day extension to file my paperwork for the Initial Brief. Therefore, the only delay within my power was the 30 day extension to submit my paperwork. Any other delay or extension was beyond my control and this letter that Mr. Hood sent to the Court does not accurately reflect what actually has transpired on this Appeal

I attempted to call the Clerk's office to determine if any action was required of me but reached voice mail. I submit this letter for purposes of clarification of the issues raised.
