

Dear Mr. Chisolm:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, opposing counsel needs to be served.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$250.00.
- A proof of service showing that a copy has been served on the Administrative Law Court has not been provided as required by Rule 203(d), SCACR.
- An amended notice of appeal will need to be served and filed. The notice of appeal shall be substantially in the format shown by Form 6 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. The notice of appeal shall only contain the name of the administrative judge, the docket number of the case before the

Administrative Law Court, the date of the decision from which the appeal is taken, the name of the party taking the appeal, and the names and addresses of all attorneys of record.
