Pursuant to Rule 208(b)(7) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, please accept the following supplemental citation to the South Carolina State Election Commission's (SEC) Motion to Dismiss Appeal as Moot which was filed April 9, 2013. After the SEC filed its Motion to Dismiss, on April 17, 2013, the South Carolina Supreme Court decided the case of South Carolina Retirement System Investment Commission v. Loftis, Op. No. 27242 (S.C. Sup. Ct. filed Apr. 17, 2013) (Shearouse Adv. Sh. No. 18 at 17). The SEC believes the Loftis case is pertinent and significant as the Court's analysis of mootness is directly applicable to and supportive of the SEC's argument Mr. Call's appeal is moot.
