## ORDER

Appellant has filed a motion for leave to file a Rule 29(b), SCRCrimP motion with the circuit court. The motion is granted, and this case is remanded to the Richland County Court of General Sessions for the limited purpose of ruling on Appellant's Rule 29(b) motion. Within ten days of the date of this order, Counsel for Appellant is ordered to file the motion with the circuit court and contact counsel for Respondent and the circuit court judge to schedule such hearings as the circuit court judge deems appropriate. This appeal will be held in abeyance pending the circuit court's ruling on the motion. Counsel for Appellant shall provide an update to the clerk of this court no later than fifteen days from the date of this order, with a copy to counsel for Respondent. Counsel for Appellant shall then provide this court with a status update every thirty days.
