This court is in receipt of Appellant-Respondent's "Notice of Supersedeas," which we construe as a request for supersedeas. After careful consideration, the request is denied. This is an appeal from a money judgment, and therefore not automatically stayed on appeal, absent an order by the lower court granting a stay. *See* Rule 241(b)(1), SCACR (providing a notice of appeal does not automatically stay the execution of a money judgment "as provided in S.C. Code Ann. § 18-9-130"); S.C. Code Ann. § 18-9-130 (A)(1) ("A notice of appeal from a judgment directing the payment of money does not stay the execution of the judgment unless the presiding judge before whom the judgment was obtained grants a stay of execution.").
