**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**



Respondents Daniel Lee Davis, individually and on behalf of all those similarly situated, pursuant to Rule 240(a) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, respectfully request an extension of time of twenty days to file their Return to Appellant's Petition for a Writ of Certiorari to review the Court of Appeals' decision in this appeal. This is Respondents' first request for an extension to this Court, and Respondents do not anticipate the need for an additional extension to file their return.
