

Once again, I have received your letter regarding the deficiency in my Record on Appeal very late. In regards to this letter, please note that my date of receipt was October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The date of your letter to me was October 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021. This placed me within one day of the ten (10) day correction time requirement. Since I viewed the deficiency as one I could correct right away, I attempted to do so. However, on October 29, 2021, our institutional mail room was closed and has not officially reopened due the fact that Broad River C.I. does not have certified mailroom staff. Incoming mail is being sorted and delivered to the dorms, but outgoing legal mail cannot be time stamped nor can copies be obtained. This of course places me in the difficult place of not being able to prove my date of receipt. I am continuing to get this proof, but am told that until SCDC can get someone who is certified to work in our mailroom there will be delays.

Today, 11/8/21, our mailroom has started sending out mail again but is still unwilling to provide time stamps, copies or other such services necessary for legal documents. In light of this information, I am sending the requested document pages and I pray the court will forgive the default and accept the missing document pages now as the delay was not an intentional act with any malice.

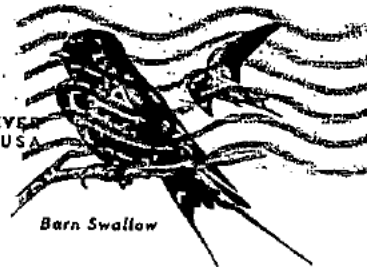
