

ORDER

This appeal was dismissed due to Appellant's failure to provide proof that he served Respondent with correspondence dated September 26, 2012. Appellant has provided proof that he served the notice of appeal on Respondent. The correspondence was filed along with the notice of appeal, but the proof of service Appellant filed with this court does not specify whether he served Respondent with the correspondence.


