
At a Court of General Sessions, convened on January 25, 2018, the Grand Jurors of Lancaster County present upon their oath:

**BREACH OF TRUST WITH FRAUDULENT INTENT**

**\$10,000 OR MORE**

That Marshall Edward Blackmon did in Lancaster County, South Carolina, on or about or between the dates of April 11, 2017 and October 9, 2017, having been entrusted by the owner, [REDACTED] with the care, keeping, and possession of certain personal property valued at \$10,000.00 or more, to wit: the Defendant did receive and cash for check #1799 in the amount of \$5,000.00, check #20031481 in the amount of \$7,000.00 and check #20031333 in the amount of \$8,000.00, all for the promise of rendering services that he neglected to honor, did with fraudulent intention feloniously convert and appropriate such property to his own use and purposes, with the intent to permanently deprive the owner thereof in violation of §16-13-230, *Code of Laws of South Carolina, (1976), as amended.*
