Court of Appeals, please forgive me for not getting in touch with you asap but I didnt know that you all required me to inform you of the legal basis for the appeal. Well, I know some law and some terms but not all. I just felt mis-treated by the system in a lot of ways so I chose to appeal my case. Here's my story and as you would please give me good advise whether I should go further with this appeal... I was picked up and apprehended on July 31, 2018 for an incident that transpired on July 8, 2018. I was scheduled a pre-liminary hearing but I never went nor was any letter sent to me for re-scheduling or stating that my hearing was held in my absence. (With this issue I would like to file under "Ineffective Counseling") I feel like my lawyer should've applied pressure on Orangeburg County to grant me a pre-liminary hearing especially with it being right. I also was denied bond several times and the reason for denial never changed. Me being a threat to the community and with me already having a violent crime on my record (Armed Robbery) canceled the chances if me receiving a bond. I thought every individual had the right to be entitled to a reasonable bond. My Motion of Discovery has alot of questionable stand points and clearly shows my innocence if evaluated. As of now I would like to appeal on the basis of "Lack of Evidence" and "Ineffective Counseling". When it comes to "Lack of Evidence" these are the things I was violated in.. They didnt ping my phones, a lie detector test wasnt given even when requested, nothing taken from the victims were found in my possession, Surveillance Cameras in apartments never showed me searching victims vehicle, and victims never pointed me out of a photo me up or described me in my Motion of Discovery... When it comes to "Ineffective Counseling" these are things I was violated in. I never went up for my pre-liminary hearing, request for lie detector test was never given and we discussed and agreed on a 7yr plea deal but nothing went as promised and as planned... Mr. Farley brought 1yrs to my attention and I didnt like the offer at first because I felt like the whole case should've been dismissed. Later I contacted Mr. Farley and told him I would plea out if the 7yrs was still the open offer. He told me the offer still stood and he would try to get the plea down to 5yrs. He then stated he would be taking me up to seal the deal on the week of Dec. 12th in front of Judge Dickerson.

cally. This is what I have and there's more conflict of interest if you would  
take the time and re-open my case and evaluate it. Hopefully this is enough  
or the courts to grant my appeal...

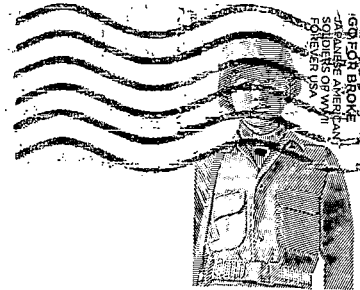
