My apologies to all concerned for missing the November 22, 2021 deadline to notify the Court of Appeals of a conflict with the proposed oral argument dates; but apparently, I have a scheduling order with Judge Norton in Federal Court, Charleston, to begin trial on March 7th, which will be a 2-3 day trial. The Court of Appeals notified us to keep March 7, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16, or 17th open for oral argument.
