

## ORDER

---

After careful consideration, Respondent's motion to strike Appellant's designated matters not presented to the lower court *in this case* is granted. See Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record shall not, however, include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal."). Appellant may not include matters presented to the lower court in related cases where those cases were not consolidated with the instant case. Because Appellant's initial brief references the stricken matters, Appellant's initial brief is also stricken. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended initial brief that shall not include references to the stricken matters. The record on appeal shall not contain the stricken matters.
