The above captioned (appellant) hereby moves upon the above court, pursuant to SCACR Rule 227 to appeal (Admin. Law Court) Order of Dismissal of the above Grievance No.

The (appellant) states that her appeal is the direct and approximate cause, of (SCDC's) accusing officer, breach of her official and SCDC Corporate policy governing, the search and "shake down" of any inmate.

The policy clearly states there must be (2) officers conducting a search and shakedown of any inmate. Consequently, to that issue all evidence must be recorded on paper (19-29A) Incident Report, photos taken and/or video surveillance can be viewed by SCDC contraband officer and security personnel. When a large quantity of "contraband" has been seized photos must be used. Inmate requested the video footage to be used at a disciplinary hearing and was not afforded this right (since no photos were available).

Note: the property taken exceeded 1 duffel bag because the officer involved instructed the inmate to put the wrong things in there. The thing is the officer failed to list every thing confiscated on the official (19-29A- Incident Report).
