ORDER

Petitioner has filed a document entitled "Actual & Constructive Judicial Cognizance, Petition for a Writ of Mandamus/Prohibition/for Lack of Extraterritorial Jurisdiction, Territorial Jurisdiction, Subject Matter Jurisdiction, Inpersonam [sic] Jurisdiction or In Rem Jurisdiction under 28 USC 1333(1)."

To the extent this document may be construed as a petition for a writ of certiorari to review the decision of the South Carolina Court of Appeals in Appellate Case Number 2020-000075, this Court will only review a final decision of the Court of Appeals, and a decision is not final for the purposes of review until a petition for rehearing or reinstatement has been acted on by the Court of Appeals. Rule 242 (a) and (c) of the South Carolina Appellate Rules (SCACR). Since no petition for rehearing or reinstatement has been ruled on by the Court of Appeals regarding the dismissal order, there is no final decision for this Court to review, and the petition for a writ of certiorari is dismissed.

To the extent this document seeks relief under Rule 245, SCACR, that request will be processed under Appellate Court Case Number 201-001458. Petitioner will be advised when the Court takes action on this request.
