ORDER

Petitioner's motion to relieve counsel and proceed *pro se* is granted.

Within twenty days of this order, Petitioner must file a written explanation under Rule 243(c) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. The explanation must contain sufficient facts, argument and citation to legal authority to show that there is an arguable basis for asserting that the circuit court's determination that this action is barred as being successive and/or untimely under the statute of limitations was improper. The failure to make a sufficient showing may result in the dismissal of this matter.
