"Did the other documents reach your office, if so this enclosed letter to Clerk Carpenter from the S.C. Court Administration, to Clerk Carpenter dated 10-8-21, telling her to provide appropriate assistance in this matter. 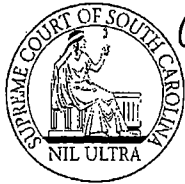
