ORDER

Appellant has appealed an order denying summary judgment and granting a motion to amend a pleading. Because this order is not appealable, this appeal is dismissed. *See Willis v. Bishop*, 276 S.C. 156, 276 S.E.2d 310 (1981) (holding the denial of a motion for summary judgment is not immediately appealable); *Collins v. Sigmon*, 299 S.C. 464, 385 S.E.2d 835 (1989) (holding an order allowing the amendment of a pleading is generally not appealable until final judgment). Because this appeal is dismissed, this court will take no action on Appellant's pending motions. The remittitur will be sent as required by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
