

ORDER


This case was dismissed on October 25, 2021, for failure to file proof of timely service of the notice of appeal upon the Administrative Law Court (ALC) as required by Rule 23, SCACR, and this court's letter of October 6, 2021. Appellant has now filed a "Rule 59(e)" motion and "Motion for Resentencing," which we construe as a petition to rehear the dismissal. Though Appellant has since filed proof of service on the ALC, the service was untimely. *See* Rule 203(b)(6), SCACR ("When a statute allows a decision of the [ALC] to be appealed directly to the Supreme Court or the Court of Appeals, the notice of appeal shall be served on the [ALC] and all parties of record within thirty (30) days after receipt of the decision."). Accordingly, the petition for rehearing is denied.
