RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR COSTS ON APPEAL

The Respondent/Appellant Shon Turner hereby moves for taxation of costs on appeal pursuant to Rules 222 and 242, SCACR. The grounds for this motion are: (1) Mr. Turner was the Appellant before the Court of Appeals, which ruled in his favor by reversing the circuit court's partial directed verdict and remanding his case for a new trial; and (2) the Petitioner/Respondent Medical University of South Carolina obtained a writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals which, following oral argument, the Supreme Court dismissed as improvidently granted.
