

ORDER

After careful consideration, Appellant's motion to strike is granted. Respondent's motion to amend the designation of matter is denied. Respondent's initial brief is stricken. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Respondent shall serve and file an amended initial brief that includes only citations to matters actually presented to the trial court. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record shall not . . . include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal."); Rule 208(b)(4), SCACR ("The brief shall contain references to the transcript; pleadings, orders, exhibits, or other materials *which may be properly included in the Record on Appeal*" (emphasis added)).
