**MOTION FOR THIRD EXTENSION OF TIME WITHIN WHICH

I.

The Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter are due to be served and filed on January 7, 2022.

II.

Pursuant to RE: Extension Requests in Criminal Direct Appeals and Post-Conviction Relief Certiorari Proceedings: Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009, the State moves for a **third** extension in the above-referenced criminal appeal and asks for an additional thirty days to complete the brief in this case. Earlier this week, the undersigned counsel submitted a Petition for Rehearing to the Court of Appeals in State v. Victoria Lorraine

Sanchez. Along with that and other responsibilities in the office, the undersigned counsel has in the past few weeks submitted a Brief of Respondent to the Court of Appeals in Charles Green, Jr. v. State and George N. Moses v. State; has submitted a Brief of Petitioner to the Court of Appeals in John Upson v. State; and has submitted a Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Supreme Court in State v. Shelby Harper Taylor.

III.






