- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, your proof of service must indicate that opposing counsel was served with your appellants' initial brief and designation of matter.
- The document is improperly paginated. Specifically, there are gaps in the numbering of pages in your initial brief.
- The designation of matter should be substantially in the format shown by Form 13 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, no other correspondence should be attached to the designation of matter.
- Please amend your initial brief and designation of matter to conform strictly to Rules 208 and 209, SCACR. No other currency or correspondence should be attached to the documents.
