



COUNT ONE

FINANCIAL TRANSACTION CARD THEFT

That Junior Parrott did in Sumter County, on or about June 23, 2010, and during a twelve-month period preceding this date, receive financial transaction cards or numbers issued in the names of two or more persons which he/she had reason to know were taken or retained under circumstances which constitute a violation of Section 16-14-20(3), where a person other than the issuer sold a financial transaction card or number or bought the same from a person other than the issuer, and Section 16-14-60(A)(3), where a person obtains control over a financial transaction card as security for debt, in violation of Section 16-14-0020(4), S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT TWO

FINANCIAL TRANSACTION CARD FRAUD

That Junior Parrott did in Sumter County on or about June 23, 2010 use a financial transaction card at Gate Petroleum, located at 231 East Liberty Street, Sumter, South Carolina, namely: a SAFE Federal Credit Union Visa debit card issued to Bertha Parrott, that was illegally obtained or retained or received with knowledge that it was illegally obtained or retained or which he/she knew to be forged, altered, expired, or obtained as a result of a fraudulent application, with the intent to defraud the issue or anyone else of something of value in the amount of five hundred dollars or less in a six-month period, in violation of Section 16-14-0060(a)(1), S. C. Code of Laws, 2003, as amended.
