ORDER

By order dated November 10, 2021, this Court dismissed this matter on the ground that Petitioner failed to provide: (1) proof of service showing the date a copy of the notice of appeal was served on Respondent, as required by Rules 243(b) and 203(d)(1)(B)(i), SCACR; and (2) a written statement indicating the date Petitioner received written notice of entry of the final order in this case, as required by Rule 203(e)(1)(C), SCACR. Petitioner has now filed a petition for rehearing of the order of dismissal. The petition for rehearing is denied.
