
MOTION TO WITHDRAW AS COUNSEL FOR APPELLANT

In accordance with Rule 1.16(b) of the South Carolina Rules of Professional Conduct, Andrew M. Connor of the law firm Nelson Mullins Riley & Scarborough LLP (“Counsel”), counsel of record for Appellant Stephanie M. McDew a/k/a Stephanie McDew Schoumacher (“Schoumacher”), hereby requests the Court’s permission to withdraw his appearance in this matter for good cause.

Here, there is good cause for granting Counsel’s Motion under Rule 1.16(b), because: “withdrawal can be accomplished without material adverse effect on the interests of the client”; “the client fail[ed] substantially to fulfill an obligation to the lawyer regarding the lawyer’s services or payment therefore and has been given reasonable warning that the lawyer will withdraw unless the obligation is fulfilled”; and “other good cause exists.” Rule 1.16(b)(1), (5), (7).

Counsel's withdrawal can be accomplished without material adverse effect on the interests of Schoumacher because no hearings are currently scheduled and no deadlines are currently pending. Therefore, there is sufficient time for Schoumacher to engage new counsel to represent her in this matter. Accordingly, Counsel moves this Court for an Order allowing his withdrawal as counsel for Schoumacher.
