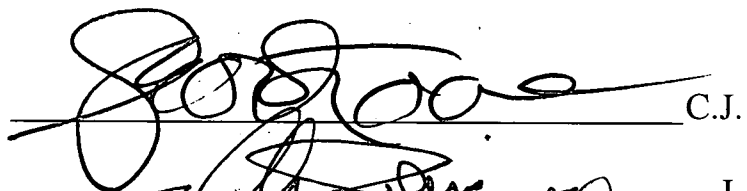
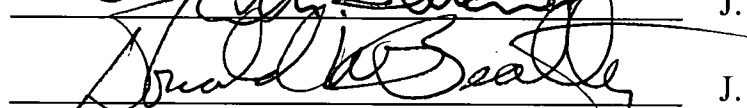

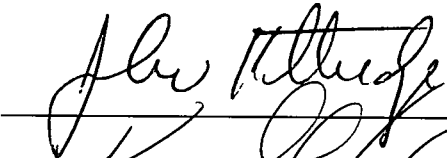
ORDER

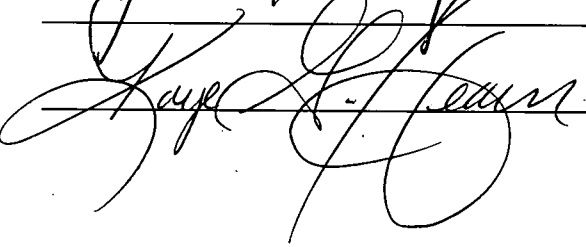
