This matter came before the South Carolina Administrative Law Court (ALC or Court) pursuant to the Notice of Appeal filed by McKinley Wright, Jr. (Appellant) seeking review of a final decision rendered by the Appellate Panel (Panel) of the South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce (Department). On October 5, 2021, after careful consideration of arguments raised in the parties' briefs, and a review of the record on appeal and the law, this court issued a Final Order Affirming the Panel's decision. On October 12, 2021, Appellant filed a motion requesting a rehearing in this matter.¹ There is no indication that Appellant served the motion upon the Respondents and the Respondents have not filed a response to the motion.

This Court has given thoughtful review and consideration to those arguments raised in the Appellant's Motion for Reconsideration. However, Appellant does not reference a single finding of fact or conclusion of law that is not based on and supported by the substantial evidence

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Appellant's Motion for Rehearing is **DENIED**.
AND IT IS SO ORDERED.
