number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Reply Brief of Petitioner in the case of George N. Moses v. The State with the Court of Appeals on December 29, 2021. Counsel filed a Motion to Hold in Abeyance in the case of Terry McCall v. The State with the South Carolina Supreme Court on December 21, 2021. Counsel filed a Reply to Respondent's Return to Appellant's Motion to Strike and Motion to Amend Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. James Winston Almond with the Court of Appeals on December 7, 2021. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of Terry Watson v. The State with the South Carolina Supreme Court on November 17, 2021.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. On December 29, 2021, opposing counsel, the Office of the Attorney General, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through January 31, 2022.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty (30) day extension, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for serving and filing the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
