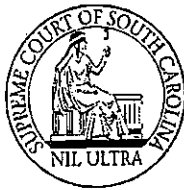

Thus, no record of when appellant received it at S.C.D.C. - Appellant, has discovered that Clerk Carpenter did not clock stamp in the Clerk of Court's office, or submit appellant's Court ordered affidavit in support of appellant's petition for a rehearing dated 11-15-21. This fact is based on the order dated 1-11-22 which states, appellants - Petition is denied for failure to comply, which is 100% error, and prejudice. See appellant's affidavit submitted to the S.C.
