"Appellant's Final argument in this appeal is in RE: to the evidence submitted showing the violations of Chester Co, Clerk of Court Sue K. Carpenter, which prejudiced appellant 100%. First evidence and objection show's that on 11-3-21. Clerk Carpenter Failed to Subpoena Juror #38. Ms. Patricia B. Received. 12-3-21. to Show how She left off her return address. Then "See the Envelope appellant sent to the S.C Court of appeals as evidence Received 1-11-22, <sup>by</sup> Clerk Carpenter "which contained the - order dated. 12-10-21. Note. She did not put her return address so - that the S.C, D.C mail room would not deem it as legal mail, Thus. No record of when appellant received the order. "But appellant already had received an appeal # 2021-001412. (Grant the new trial)
