I sent paperwork showing I filed under the 1 year limitation of the newly discovered laws that I found out in letter by Alan Wilson to Bryan Stirling sent in June 28, 2019. It's a due process claim, for Statutory Construction Intent for sentencing. The 1995 24-13-150A statute attaches itself to all sentences except a sentence of life or a death sentence. Legislature did not exempt my sentence actually S.C. 24-21-560A made only exception for a life or death sentence.

S.C. 24-13-150A is all encompassing the legislature did not intend any other exceptions to be applicable.

In my transcript the State attorney
