



that Counsel had not obtained the evidence that Counsel motioned the court for, Petitioner also noticed the court that Counsel had not visited Petitioner to prepare for this hearing, and that Counsel was making an attempt to present Petitioner's PCR the way he wanted, instead of assisting Petitioner with presenting Petitioner's PCR, Counsel tried to choose which issues to present, Counsel motioned the court for the funds to have this evidence, the court granted the motion, after Counsel told the court that this evidence was needed, to establish Petitioner's Brady violation. On December 1, 2021 Counsel tried to conduct Petitioner's PCR hearing without this evidence, that Counsel stood before the court and told the court that this evidence was needed, to establish the Brady violation, this evidence also establishes other violations within Petitioner's PCR, without notice Counsel tried to conduct Petitioner's PCR without this evidence. Petitioner objected, the court tried to compel Petitioner to proceed, Petitioner refused to proceed without the evidence and moved the court for another attorney, the court denied Petitioner's motions, and the court stated that Petitioner failed to prosecute.

Petitioner being put in the position to proceed without the evidence needed, an counsel who was not assisting Petitioner, instead, was trying to conduct Petitioners PCR and making the attempt to raise the issues he wanted to raise, Petitioner only option was to object, then move this court for reinstatement of Petitioner PCR. Petitioner has not had that one bite of the apple that the Constitution guarantees. Petitioners moves this court for a PCR hearing and be provided with the evidence that the court has already granted, with counsel to assist Petitioner, not try to present Petitioner PCR in the way he chooses. Petitioner has no choice but to present this appeal in this manner. this yard is locked-down. and Petitioner has health issues that has confined Petitioner to a wheelchair and Petitioner jaw has been broke since June of 2020
