Judge Dickson,

I've requested a continuance concerning this hearing because I have had problems logging in for two previous virtual hearings. This hearing for a Partial Summary Judgement by the plaintiff's was originally scheduled for 12/17/21, but the plaintiff's lawyer, Stephan Futeral, requested a continuance at that time and it was granted by Judge Cothran although Mr. Futeral did not provide a reason for his request for a continuance. I verbally objected and wanted the motion to be heard then, but Judge Cothran overruled my objection. Mr. Futeral has stated in an email to the court that his clients do not consent to a continuance which seems highly irregular that the court needs their permission in order to grant a continuance. I believe that Mr. Futeral asked for the continuance specifically because he doesn't want me to be heard and may have known this would be scheduled for a virtual hearing. The Court of Common Pleas has granted the majority of the plaintiff's requests in this litigation and has not allowed any of my motions to be heard at any time. My complaint case #2021-CP-10-2848 was consolidated on 1/6/22 by Judge McCoy. Now Mr. Futeral is asking the court to dismiss all my counterclaims in his *MOTION FOR SANCTIONS FOR DEFENDANT'S FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH AN ORDER OF DISCOVERY* filed 1/21/22 and requesting that I be incarcerated again until I pay a \$1214 sanction ordered by Judge Cothran.

For the reasons mentioned above and because Mr. Futeral has committed fraud upon the court in these proceedings and there may have been an abuse of discretion by other court officials, I have appealed certain judgements concerning past sanctions with the South Carolina Appellate Court on 1/10/22 that is pending.

Mr. Futeral filed the Motion for Summary Judgement on 6/16/21 (7) seven days after the plaintiff's original complaint was filed on 6/9/21, but I have never been given an opportunity to voice my counterclaim that Pet Helpers Inc, committed fraud in the adoption of my dog Toby and their lawyer concealed evidence of the adoption submission that was faked by Ms. Melissa Susko and her employees.

You will find attached documents that I filed in opposition to the Partial Summary Judgement by the Plaintiff which should not be granted because I have not had the opportunity to be heard concerning my counterclaims and aspects of this case are pending appeal. Those documents are also attached for Judge Dickson,
