ORDER

On November 17, 2021, this court granted Respondents' motion to strike and directed Appellant to serve and file an amended record on appeal that included all matters designated by all parties and excluded annotations and markings. Since that order, several motions have been filed.

First, Appellant's motions for clarification are denied. Second, Appellant's motion to supplement the record on appeal with matters that were filed in the lower court is granted.

Third, Respondents' motion to consolidate this appeal with the appeal in Appellate Case No. 2021-000121 is denied. Appellant's motion to quash the motion to consolidate is denied as moot.

Fourth, Respondents' motion to dismiss is denied at this time. Within twenty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve a full record on appeal on Respondents. The record on appeal shall include all matters designated by both parties and omit any extraneous annotations or markings. Failure of Appellant to comply may result in the dismissal of this appeal. Fifth, Respondents' motion for an extension of time to serve and file Respondents' final brief is granted. Respondents shall serve and file Respondents' final brief within twenty days of service of the record on appeal.
