Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I write in response to the Appellant's letter, dated February 8, 2022.

At this point, I will cease arguing over which of my letters the Appellant has received or when she might have received them. To the extent that the Appellant affirms to this Court that she has not received any letter that I have sent via U.S. Mail to her address of record, I will take her at her word.

That said, the Appellant does acknowledge receipt of my February 3, 2022, letter in which I enclosed the entirety of a redacted bank file. The file in question was the exact same redacted file I sent back in June. I have now twice provided redacted documents to the Appellant, and it is my understanding that the Court has requested the Appellant amend the Record. If the Court considers the current Record, containing unredacted information, to be complete, then I would need that directive, so I can proceed with final briefing. My ultimate goal is to ensure my clients' personal and financial information is not made public. The current Record, if posted online, presents an issue for my clients.

Lastly, I take issue with Exhibits F and G to the Appellant's letter. Those exhibits relate to another lawsuit filed by the Appellant, Case No. 2018-CP-18-1661, which is pending in the Dorchester County Court of Common Pleas and which is not before this Court. After my departure from my old firm, I am no longer involved in that case, but that does not change the fact that the exhibits have no bearing on this appeal.

I stand ready to act in accordance with any decision by this Court.
