This matter comes before this Court pursuant to an **Appeal filed by the Tenant/Appellant Defendant, Rodger Gamble, pro se'**. Said Appeal was filed with the Clerk of Court for Horry County on Wednesday, August 11, 2021, following a pretrial conference and Motion hearing prior to entering the courtroom for a Jury trial requested by Defendant, Rodger Gamble Jury, on the same date.

The matter originally came before this Court as a *transfer case from the Little River Summary Court (Judge Gerald T. Whitley) when the defendant requested a Jury trial on April 16, 2021.* The matter that was filed before the Little River Summary Court was through the plaintiff, Priscilla Calvo, who filed an

Mr. Gamble begged of the court to grant him an opportunity to go and get the funds from the bank to post said bond. Since the Court had not completed it's pretrial process of other cases scheduled for the day, Mr. Gamble was given the opportunity to get the funds, and be back at the Court with the bond by 10 A.M. He left and never returned.


Upon discussion with Plaintiff Calvo of the recent ruling of Supreme Court extending the eviction moratorium until August 3, 2021, the court continued the matter until the next term of court; August 9-13, 2021.

A status conference was scheduled on July 20, 2021. Plaintiff Calvo appeared pro 'se; the defendant did not. The matter was set (at Plaintiff's choice) for trial again on day-certain, Wednesday, August 11, 2021. Both parties were notified in writing by the Court, as is procedure, of that date. Both parties were present on Wednesday, August 11, 2021 in Myrtle Beach, SC. Again a pretrial conference was held whereby Plaintiff Calvo motioned the Court that Defendant was still not current with the bond; two (2) past-due payments were made, but he was still in arrears for July and August, totaling \$1,300. The Court again inquired of Mr. Gamble why he was refusing to abide by the Court's orders, had previously lied and never returned to the Court on June 11, 2021. His reply again was that money was no problem, but just wanted to go to trial.

The Court explained to Mr. Gamble the land-lord/Tenant procedure and that the matter could not get before a jury until procedure was followed. The Court considered holding Mr. Gamble in contempt, but heeded Plaintiff's motion to put her possession of her property in that additional problems had come between the parties whereby 'access' to the property was an issue. This court granted plaintiff's motion pursuant to Section 27-40-790 (c), paragraph 2. The court asked both parties to await the preparation of the eviction notice so that each could be personally served. Mr. Gamble left the building, again violating the court's order, but was stopped on site as he attempted to leave the grounds by the Deputy Sheriff on duty. Both parties were served with the writ for eviction to take place in 48 hours... August 13, 2021 by 5:00 p.m. Mr. Gamble debated with the Court on short notice, but was advised that the court could have done a 24-hour eviction. He went directly to the Clerk of Court, appealing the eviction. An Appeal bond hearing was scheduled, per statute for Tuesday, August 17, 2021 @ 9 a.m. The court set the appeal bond @ \$1,300 dollars to be paid within 24 hours, and each month thereafter @ \$650, until the Circuit Court heard the appeal... the bond becoming due on September 10, 2021. (Mr. Gamble paid the \$1300 to Plaintiff in court w/receipt given). This Court concludes that Mr. Gamble has not shown any respect for any respect for court rulings thus far, has been and still remains disrespectful to both


Plaintiff and the Court. This Court encloses copies of its file contents to the higher court respectfully requesting that the Appeal as filed by Defendant Gamble be dismissed and Plaintiff Calvo issued an immediate writ of possession at the noted property address, pursuant to statute.



- 3) This Court made every effort to follow the Law as well as summary court civil procedure in this and each case


