MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO PAY FILING FEE

(Amended with Exhibits)

- 1. On 1 February 2022, Chief Judge H. Bruce William denied the Appellant’s amended Motion to proceed without prepayment of costs pursuant to Ex Parte Martin v. the State 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 despite her assertion of fundamental right to privacy under the U.S. Constitution. Here, the Appellant requests an additional 30 days to pay the required \$250 filing fee and states the following in support:
2. On 17 December 2021, the United States District Court for the District of South Carolina entered orders (Ex. 1, Ex. 2) granting her Motion for Extension of Time to Appeal to the U.S. Court of Appeals, Fourth Circuit (USCA4), pursuant to Fed. R. App. P. 4(a)(5)(A) in the matters of Hunter El v. Hunter (C/A No. 3:21-2928 MBS) and Hunter v. Hunter El (C/A No. 3:21-2929 MBS) for good cause. Two months ago, the Appellant stated she was homeless

and that the ejection had an adverse impact on her physical, emotional, educational and financial well-being. Here, the Appellant respectfully request that additional time to pay the filing fee because these conditions persist and also because she is pursuing relief in multiple courts simultaneously.

3. On 3 January 2022, the Appellant filed her Notice of Appeal with the USCA4 with the clerk of the U.S. District Court for the District of South Carolina (Ex. 3, Ex. 4). In the federal court, a text order was entered allowing the Appellant to continue without costs (Ex. 5, Ex. 6).
4. On 4 January 2022, the deputy clerk of the USCA4 sent the transmittal sheet(s) for Notice of Appeal to the USCA for both cases (Ex. 7, Ex. 8).
5. On 5 January 2022, James C. Campbell, the Clerk of Court for the Sumter County Court of Common Pleas sent a “*Notice of Case Scheduling*” (Ex. 9) that stated that the matter of Hunter v. Hunter (Case No. 2021CP4301534, Roster ID: 377) would be reheard on 31 January 2022. The Appellant planned to appear via WebEx but on Monday, 31 January 2021, at 9:38 a.m., Mr. Jackson stated the matter was still pending and would not be on the roster for that day (Ex. 10).
6. Thus, since the retirement of former Chief Judge James E. Lockemy much of the Appellant’s time was spent preparing for the local court hearing which never occurred instead of accumulating the monies required to pay this court’s filing fee or complete the informal briefings due to the USCA4.
7. Furthermore, on 6 January 2022, the Clerk of the USCA4 docketed the cases and entered Informal Briefing Orders (Ex. 11, Ex. 12) (Case No. 22-1015—Hunter El v. Hunter et al. and

Case No. 22-1021—Elijah Hunter v. Regina Hunter El) due on 31 January 2022, the same day set for the local court hearing that did not occur.

8. Then, on 3 February 2022, the USCA4 prematurely issued [Rule 45] notices for øf failure to file informal briefings (Ex. 13, Ex. 14) contrary to Rule 26(b), Rule 26(c), and Rule 27(1)(2), Fed. R. App. P.
9. Thus, on 3 February 2022, the Appellant also moved for a Motion for Extension of Time to File Informal Briefs in both cases. (No. 22-1021, No. 22-105) (Ex. 15, Ex. 16). On 4 February 2022, the USCA4 Clerk entered an order(s) (Ex. 17, Ex. 18) granting a 25-day extension, until 28 February 2022 to file her informal briefs.
10. Further, the Appellant’s initial registration for the CM/ECF, made in November 2021, was denied because she did not have not have an active case with the Court then (Ex. 19). However, after her cases were docketed and she registered again, her electronic filing was approved. Her ECF account was only activated for filing on 2 February 2022 with the assistance from the Court’s technical support desk (Ex. 20).

THEREFORE, the Appellant prays the Court will grant additional time to pay the required filing fee to proceed on appeal<sup>1</sup>.

**ORDER**

These actions involve efforts by Plaintiff/Defendant Regina Hunter El to avoid execution of a writ of ejectment entered by Defendant Sumter County, South Carolina, Magistrate Court on or about September 3, 2021 in favor of Defendant/Plaintiff Elijah Hunter. Hunter El filed her complaint against Hunter and the Sumter County Magistrate Court on September 13, 2021. See Hunter El v. Hunter, C/A No. 3:21-2928-MBS. She also removed the Magistrate Court proceeding on September 13, 2021. See Hunter v. Hunter El, C/A No. 3:21-2929-MBS. At the same time, she pursued an appeal of Hunter v. Hunter El through the Sumter County Court of Common Pleas. The court determined that it lacked jurisdiction over these actions. By order filed October 18, 2021, the court

summarily dismissed Hunter El v. Hunter and remanded Hunter v Hunter El to the Sumter County Court of Common Pleas.

This matter is before the court on emergency motion to stay writ of ejectment filed in Hunter v. Hunter El, which motion was filed by Hunter El on October 18, 2021, subsequent to the case being closed. Also before the court is motion for extension of time to file an appeal, which motion was filed by Hunter El in both cases on November 22, 2021.

A. Emergency Motion for a Stay

Hunter El states that the writ of ejectment was executed on October 14, 2021, despite the matter having been removed to this court. Hunter El states that her belongings were put out and her infirm father removed from the dwelling. Hunter El further states that a stay is necessary to allow her to proceed with her legal remedies in state court. Hunter El moves the court to stay the ejectment or at least order reasonable relief to allow her to relocate her elderly father and his medical supplies and equipment.

The court is sympathetic to Hunter El's plight. However, for the reasons set forth in its October 18, 2021 order, the court is without jurisdiction to intervene in the state court matter. Hunter El's emergency motion for a stay (ECF No. 19) is **denied**.

B. Motion for Extension of Time to File Appeal

Rule 4(a)(1)(A) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure provides:

In a civil case, . . . the notice of appeal required by Rule 3 must be filed with the district clerk within 30 days after the judgment or order appealed from is entered.

The thirty-day time for filing a notice of appeal is mandatory and jurisdictional. Thompson v. E.I. DuPont de Nemours & Co., 76 F.3d 530, 532 (4<sup>th</sup> Cir. 1996) (quoting Shah v. Hutto, 722 F.2d 1167, 1167 (4<sup>th</sup> Cir. 1983)). However, pursuant to Fed. R. App. P. 4(a)(5)(A),

The district court may extend the time to file a notice of appeal if:

(i) a party so moves no later than 30 days after the time prescribed by this Rule 4(a) expires; and

(ii) regardless of whether its motion is filed before or during the 30 days after the time prescribed by this Rule 4(a) expires, that party shows excusable neglect or good cause.

Hunter El seeks to appeal the court's October 18, 2021 order. See Fed. R. App. P. 4(a)(7) (defining "entry"). Thirty days from October 18, 2021 was November 17, 2021. Hunter El's November 22, 2021 motion for extension of time was filed within 30 days after the November 17, 2021 deadline. The question is whether Hunter El shows either excusable neglect or good cause.

Hunter El states that she is homeless and that her portable building and its contents were damaged when it was towed. Hunter El states that the execution of the writ of ejectment adversely affected her physically, emotionally, financially, and delayed her education. She seeks an extension of time until December 22, 2021 to file notices of appeal.

The court finds that Hunter El has shown good cause. Under Fed. R. App. P. 4(a)(5)(C), no extension under Rule 4 "may exceed 30 days after the prescribed time or 14 days after the date when the order granting the motion is entered, whichever is later." In this case, 30 days after the prescribed time expires on December 17, 2021. Therefore, the court grants Hunter El's motion for extension of time for a period of 14 days after the date the within order is entered.
