MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for petitioner respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in the case of Demarcus Robinson v. The State with this Court on January 25, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


