I Harold Wilson am appealing the decision of the Court of Common Pleas, on Jan 4, by Honorable Judge Micheal Hoyt, to dismiss my case, for I believe my rights to a fair hearing and the opportunity to be heard were violated. This case is about a house that me and my mother Dorothy Hatcher, brought in 2007. Both my name and my mothers name is on the deed. My mother passed away in 2012, and my aunt Cynthia Barnett presented a will my mother made to the Darlington Probate Court and they probated the will, even though my mother had another will that she had made in 2009 which would void the old will that she made in 1989. The Darlington Probate Court has possession of the will my mother made in 2009 on file. I filed an Appeal and my case was in the court on common pleas waiting to come up on docket to be heard. Because the will that was probated was not the 1st will she made, in which in the will she made in 2009 she stated that all other wills will be voided. In October of 2021 I recieved a letter from the court of Common Pleas that there was a hearing for Jan 4 2022, for a motion to dismiss my case, file by Cynthia Barnett (my Aunt) and her Attorney Gena Ervin. When I recieved the letter I had covid and was running a very high fever at that time. I called the clerk of court and told them I was pretty sick at that time and they told me I could file a motion for Contenance. I went and got a \$25 dollar money order to cover the filing fee, and had a motion for contenance, filed because of my sickness. But they told me it was denied, and the hearing went on with out me there.

I Harold Wilson am 61 years old now. And me  
an my mother brought this house together in 2009  
and its paid for. My mother Dorothy Hatcher  
passed away in 2012 so the house is still deeded  
in her name and mine. The hearing that was scheduled  
to be heard on Jan, 4, 2022, I notified the court ahead  
of time to let them know I had covid-19 and was  
experiencing respiratory problems with my breathing,  
and I was running a High ~~temp~~ temptature. Even  
if I would have attempted to come in that condition  
they prabaly wouldnt have let me in because  
of my High temptature, because I was told  
they do a temptature check when you come in  
the court house. I filed a motion for countenance  
in the common pleas court because I was  
very sick, but they denied it and went on with  
the hearing, without me being there, not giving  
me a chance to be heard, a chance to  
cross examine and call witnesses etc.

I believe my rights to a fair hearing has been  
violated according to the Due process law.

A person shall not be denied life, liberty, or  
property without the opportunity to be heard.
