

DECLARATION
IN SUPPORT OF
MOTION TO

I, John K. Wilson Jr. # 295493, am the Appellant in the above entitled case. In support of Title 38 28 1915 (b)(1) section; Appellant show in Case No. 2011-CP-31-00069 (Attached Document), Appellant formerly proceed in forma pauperis. By Title 38 28 Section 1915 (b)(2), Appellant can not pay filing fee. With in Appellant trust fund account is issued insufficient for filing "Ex part Rec", 307 SC, 77, 415, S.E. 2d. 819 (1992) ("Inmate account reflect^(S) \$36.30 per month, KQ qualifies as indigent status for filing service and collection^(S) fee^(S)).

Appellant will suffer more of an injury (loss) to his medical issue if denied this pauperis status, which would violate his due process of law - "liberty, life, or property", guaranteed by his (14th) XIV Amendment. Appellant (1st) I Amendment guarantee^(S) him Access to this court and to petition the government for a redress of grievance. And by the refusal of this "In forma pauperis" motion, would deprive Appellant of access to court - "Hoyaca Volhoyaca", 347, SC, 26, 322, S.E. 2d. 763 (2002) ("The refusal of the family court to process divorce, without filing fee^(S)", where inmate was indigent, deprives inmate of access to the court^(S)). Appellant therefore request granting of his In forma pauperis motion.
