MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO  
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

---

Counsel for Theodore Jerry Bolick, respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension until April 13, 2022**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Theodore Jerry Bolick, respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Craig Corey Cooper with the Court of Appeals on March 7, 2022. Counsel appeared before the Court of Appeals for oral argument in the case of The State v. Phillip Lowery on March 8, 2022. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of Robert T. Gentry v. The State with the South Carolina Supreme Court on February 24, 2022. Counsel appeared for oral argument before the Court of Appeals in the case of Dameion Rivers v. The State on February 16, 2022. Counsel filed the Brief of Respondent in the case of In the Interest of Christopher H., A Juvenile with the South Carolina Supreme Court on February 14, 2022. Counsel filed the Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of Victor Weldon McCoy v. The State with the South Carolina Supreme Court on January 19, 2022. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Robin Gray Reese v. The State with the Court of Appeals on January 4, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




