To whom it may concern my name is Tanya Murphy. Mr. Murphy is seeking to have case 2021-000751 reheard based off of facts the victim settled a case for \$65,000. The attorney charged \$16,250 for his attorney fees, \$4,138.89. The victim also paid his medical expenses from this settlement and attorney's lien (Andrew Kunz) \$7,877.62. This left the victim with \$36,847.25. The last paragraph of the settlement states

* It is my understanding that should any other medical providers, insurance companies, medicare and/or medicaid, request to be reimbursed regarding our accident on 4/11/16, it is my responsibility and NOT the responsibility of Hayes and Hayes, LLC.

This leaves the victim with unforeseen obligations that he was incompetent to reach such an agreement.
