## ORDER

Appellant has filed a petition for supersedeas seeking a stay of her eviction. This court temporarily granted the stay pending this court's receipt and review of the return. After careful consideration of the parties' filings, the temporary stay is lifted and Appellant's petition for supersedeas is denied.

Appellant has also filed a motion to relieve her counsel. This court directed Attorney Johnny Elliot Watson, Sr. to file a return to the motion by noon on March 18, 2022. Having received no return, this court grants Appellant's motion to relieve counsel. This appeal will be held in abeyance for thirty days to allow Appellant to retain new counsel. New counsel shall file a notice of appearance within thirty days or this court will presume Appellant is proceeding pro se. The order on appeal shall not be stayed during this time.
