COURT OF APPEALS DATED FILED MARCH 1, 2022 DUE TO FRAUD UPON THE COURT, OBSTRUCTION OF JUSTICE AND CHALLENGE TO THE S.C. COURT OF APPEALS JURISDICTION TO ISSUE THIS ORDER. THE CASE WAS PROPERLY REMOVED TO CASE 9:21-cv-02526-TLW-MHC IN THE S.C. DISTRICT COURT DIVESTING THE S.C. COURT OF APPEALS JURISDICTION TO ISSUE IT. 
## ORDER


