I represent the appellants in the above styled action (Donita and Jimmie Harmon).

Unfortunately 4 1/2 weeks ago I fell on the tennis court and broke my left shoulder. My condition is improved and I have been able to return to work, but I am still unable to use my left hand. That has slowed my work more than I had expected.

I am therefore requesting a 30 day extension to file the appellant's brief in Mitchell v Albertelli et al 2020 02 01173. This would be the first extension in this action.

The attorney for the Albertelli defendants, Brad Brodie, Esq, has consented to the extension. I have not heard from the attorney for the plaintiffs, Grady Jordan. I confirmed with his office that my request that he consent had been received. He was not in his office when I called.
