ORDER

This appeal arises out of the Administrative Law Court's order holding Appellant's appeal in abeyance. Because the underlying order is not final, this appeal is dismissed. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 1-23-610(A)(1) (Supp. 2019) (providing judicial review may only be sought from a final decision of the Administrative Law Court); *Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hosp. Auth. v. S.C. Dep't of Health & Envtl. Control*, 387 S.C. 265, 267, 692 S.E.2d 894 (2010) ("If there is some further act which must be done by the court prior to a determination of the rights of the parties, the order is interlocutory."). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
