I would like to request a continuance on the hearings; Partial Summary Judgement, and Sanctions for Failure to Comply with Discovery Requests scheduled for April 22, 2022 @ 9:30am for the following reasons:

1. My appeal is still pending with the SC Court of Appeals concerning irregularities such as Mr. Futeral, the Plaintiff's attorney, committing fraud upon the court by making false statements to obtain restraining orders against me specifically that I trespassed on his client's property and threatened Pet Helpers employees.
2. The abuse of discretion by other court officials in the Charleston County Court of Common Pleas in not allowing me to present evidence to defend myself from Mr. Futeral's false accusations mentioned in #2 and filed with my appeal in the SC Appellate Court and also in my objections in the lower court to further sanctions, partial summary judgement or further punitive actions by the lower court.
