CONSENT MOTION TO INCREASE PAGE LIMITS

Pursuant to Rules 240 and 242 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Petitioners Fisher Controls International LLC and Crosby Valve, LLC (“Petitioners”) respectfully request that the Court issue an order increasing the page limit for the petition for writ of certiorari to 40 pages. Respondents have consented to an increase in the page limit for the petition and, in return, Petitioners consent to the order additionally setting the page limit for Respondents’ return to the petition for certiorari at 40 pages.

Petitioners seek review of a 57-page published opinion issued by the Court of Appeals. Petitioners assert that an increase in the page limit for their petition is appropriate and necessary because this appeal from a two-week asbestos trial involves four issues on appeal, plus several sub-issues. Petitioners further assert that due to the complexity of the case and depth of the issues, an increase of the page limits is justified and necessary for Petitioners to adequately present the
