Dear Mr. Tompkins

The Court is in receipt of documents that are presumed to be in response to the Court's deficiency letter dated March 17, 2022. The deficiencies outlined in that letter must be corrected in their entirety before this appeal can proceed. The following deficiencies are still outstanding and you have ten (10) days to cure the deficiencies or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, the **addresses** of those who were served need to be on the proof of service, including the Administrative Law Court and the South Carolina Department of Corrections. The date you initially served them must be on the proof of service.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$250.00. A motion to waive costs may be served and filed in lieu of the filing fee.
