The Petition for Rehearing in the above captioned direct appeal was filed on February 11, 2022. Said Motion was denied by Order of the Court of Appeals on February 24, 2022. Accordingly, Appellant's Petition for Writ of Certiorari was due on or before today's date. My father passed away this past Tuesday. We laid him to rest on Saturday, March 26, 2022. Because I am an only child, and my mother is in failing health, it fell to me to make all the arrangements for my father's funeral service in addition to preparing and giving Dad's eulogy. The last week has been a blur.

I sincerely believe a Petition for Writ of Certiorari is warranted in this case and had filed a Petition for Rehearing in this matter for that reason. At this time I would ask for a twenty (20) day extension of time in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari behalf of Mr. Cameron. I did not get to discuss this matter with opposing Counsel today. For that reason I am requesting that the State make the Court aware of their position on this request directly. 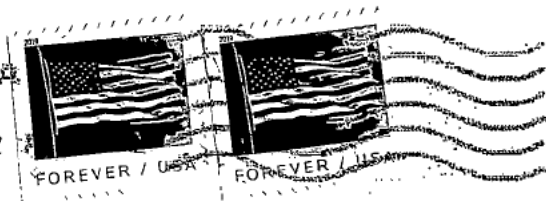
